

SANTA YNEZ CHUMASH TRIBE PURCHASES LAND IN SANTA YNEZ

SANTA YNEZ, CA – April 2, 2010 – Escrow closed on the Santa Ynez Band of Chumash Indians' purchase of the 1,390-acre ranch commonly known as "Camp Four."

Discussions regarding the sale of this land began with Fess Parker Enterprises several months ago and the tribal membership voted on and approved the land purchase.

"Our decision to purchase this land was made as a tribe," said Vincent Armenta, Tribal Chairman of the Santa Ynez Band of Chumash Indians. "The land is historically significant to our tribe and we are excited to own it."

Terms of the sale were not disclosed.
